

OMNES CAPITAL Takes a Stake in CCE HOLDING

About the Deal

Jank Weiler Operenyi, part of the Deloitte Legal network, advised CCE Holding on Omnes Capital's acquisition of a stake in its business. Cerha Hempel, Arqis and Carey Abogados advised the buyer.

CCE was created through the 2021 merger of two photovoltaic developers: Austria-based Clean Capital Energy and Germany-based Enernovum. The firm specialises in the realisation, financing and operational management of large PV ground-mounted systems and commercial PV roof systems, and boasts a project pipeline of more than four gigawatts.

Omnes Capital is a French investment fund. With its entry into CCE's business, it is expected that the latter firm's pipeline projects will receive particular attention and both organisations' long-term property portfolios will see expansion.
